For a successful application, please send the following documents per email:

- electronic version (pdf) of the dissertation
- abstract of the dissertation (maximum one page)
- letter of recommendation by the supervisor at the Center (maximum one page)
- brief CVwith information about special scientific activities (publications, posters/presentations at conferences, etc.)
- pdf files of relevant publications concerning the dissertation
- Your brief statement about what made your dissertation an outstanding success

The doctoral degree procedure at the university has to be completed between January 2016 and October 2018. Dissertations may be submitted only once in the Graduate Students' Award competition.

The Awards Ceremony will take place at the Graduate Students' Day, December 2018.
